- Cache Destination File List...
- Process Security And Shares...
- Use Partial File Updating
 - Right side uses Remote Service
 - No full copying if service unavailable
 - Request only one file at a time
 - Fast Mode (process target directly - no temp file. Left To Right is always fast.)
- Alternate Data Streams...
- Use Cache Database For Source
- Left side listing uses Remote Service
- Right side listing uses Remote Service
 - Use different folders for communication...
- If the Destination Machine Modifies Received Files, Changing Their Sizes Upon Reception, Then Copy Such Updated Files Back

Versioning Synthetic Backups More

- Keep multiple backup versions: older versions per file
- Only On Right-Hand Side
- Move into folder:
- As a subfolder in each folder
- Recreate tree below one "Older" folder
- Filename Encoding - On Right Side, Put Timestamp Into File Names
(Recommended for Use With Restore Wizard - Also Preserves Timestamps on FTP Sites)
